ELIGIBILITY FOR SCHOLARSHIP

SCHOLARSHIPS WILL BE BASED ENTIRELY ON A LOTTERY DRAWING.

SCHOLARSHIPS WILL BE FOR ONE YEAR ONLY.

APPLICANTS MUST APPLY EACH YEAR, UP TO FOUR YEARS.

- I. Grandchildren* of members in good standing of L.U.164 Retirees Association.
- II. In the case of death of a member in good standing, his grandchildren shall remain eligible .
- III. Each applicant must be a high school graduate in or prior to the year of filing their application.
- IV. Each applicant must complete all requirements for admission to the college of his choice, and same must be an accredited institution.
- V. Each freshman applicant must supply proof of acceptance to an accredited college. Students entering sophomore, junior or senior years must supply their G.P.A. from the college they are attending. If these students plan to change colleges proof of acceptance to the new college must be supplied.
- VI. Each applicant must file an application form with the Retirees Association Scholarship Committee no later than May 15th of each year.
- VII. Once a scholarship winner is admitted to college his scholarship will be renewed for the following semester only.
- VIII. If serious or chronic illness intervenes after a winner has been selected the scholarship will be held in abeyance for one academic year.
- IX. Winners are expected to carry a full academic load of classes appropriate for their chosen curriculum and to begin study within one year after being notified.
- X. Scholarships are not transferable and are forfeited if the student withdraws or fails to meet the standards of scholarship deemed necessary for graduation.

*Grandchildren---must be a natural grandchild or the natural child of an adopted child.
